Plans for this year's art in the nave exhibition are progressing well, we are busy recruiting artists to exhibit their work at St Mary's and at this relatively early stage, there are approximately twenty artists who have booked a space to display their work. We are hopeful that at least ten more will join for the three day festival.

Visitors to the exhibition will be able to view and purchase a wide selection of excellent paintings, sculpture, textiles, glass, ceramics, silverware and hand-made jewellery. The Festival will offer something for everyone and will be a great opportunity for a family day out. Facilities will include light refreshments teas, coffees and a licensed bar.

The purpose of Art in the Nave, beyond the fact that it will provide a facility for artists, drawn mainly from Herts, Beds and Bucks to exhibit their work, shall be to raise much needed funds to support parish running costs and provide an important opportunity for us to engage with our wider community.

This year, we are also supporting three locally based charities and so donations from the proceeds raised at the event will support The Hospice of St Francis, The Dacorum Emergency Night Shelter and the UK Langa Township Pre school Trust.

However, we will need many willing volunteers to steward the event. If you haven't done so already and you would like to lend a hand, do please get in touch. Any time you can spare, will of course be very much appreciated. The dates and opening times for Art in the Nave are as follows:
