Tonight at 6.30pm please join us at St Mary's for our Feast of Patron (Patronal Festival) as we sing hymns and celebrate Mary! All welcome.

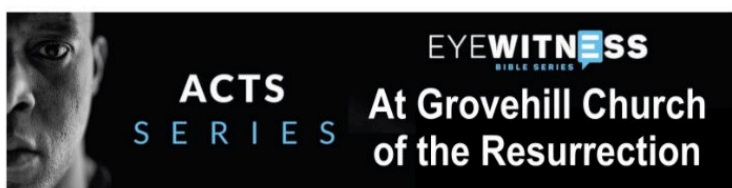
'EYE WITNESS' - AN AUTUMN COURSE FOR THE TEAM CHURCHES
