### ST ALBANS DIOCESAN SYNOD 2024-2027 ELECTIONS

A new Diocesan Synod must be elected this year and will take office on 1st August 2024. Our Deanery is required to elect 3 members to the House of Laity, and any lay person who is an actual communicant of 16 years or upwards and whose name is entered on the electoral roll of any parish in the Deanery is eligible. 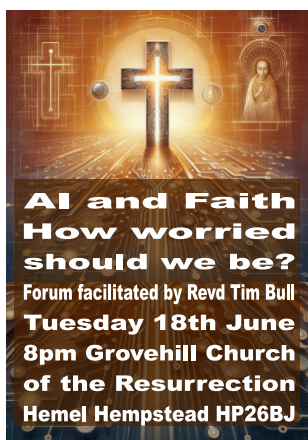
