# **ANDREW'S 2025 CYCLING IN AID OF DENS**

Hello all, I've completed my first sponsored bike ride in aid of our local charity, DENS. I joined over 3,300 other cyclists on the start of the 'Dragon Ride' in the Brecon Beacons of Wales. I completed the 134 mile (215km) route in a total time including stops of 10h 18m. It wasn't as hot as around Hemel and was so windy we were pedalling hard downhill. It was the most ascent I've ever done at 10,300 feet.

This September I'll be attempting DENS' longest ever Hillbuster as they've added a 93 mile (150km) route for 2025. Thank you so much to those who have been able to donate so far.
